The M.A. Program of International Development (Glocal) at the Faculty of Social Sciences, the Hebrew University of Jerusalem seeks to fill a tenure-track position (alternative ranks: Lecturer, Senior Lecturer or Associate Professor), commencing Fall 2019.

The Call is open to outstanding candidates in all areas and sub-fields of International Development, broadly construed, including in particular Community Development. Applicants must hold a Ph.D. degree at the time of hire, and demonstrate an active research program, indicating the potential for outstanding scholarship. The language of teaching at our Program is English.

The position is likely to be half-anchored in the International Development Program and half-anchored in a related department or Faculty. Candidates are thus requested to apply as soon as possible also to the relevant Department/s or Faculty/Faculties, in which they have substantive research interests (e.g., International Relations, Political Science, Sociology and Anthropology, Social Work, Business Management, Economics, European Forum, Geography, Law), and to **note in their application to us, which additional Department/School/Faculty they have applied to.**

The deadline for applications is **October 10, 2018.**

The applicants will be asked to upload in a **single PDF file:**

- A letter of intent stating willingness to begin teaching in the fall of 2019;
- A list of required and elective courses that can be taught by the candidate in the field of international development;
- A scientific biography outlining research orientation and research plans for the coming years;
- A Curriculum Vitae, including teaching experience and practical experience in the field of international development;
- Teaching evaluations (if such exist);
- A complete list of publications;

- Copies of up to 3 recent publications;
- Three letters of recommendation. The candidate should ask the referees to send their letters of recommendation directly to Prof. Guy Harpaz by the deadline stipulated above.
